

JSTS Minutes of September 21, 2011 Meeting

Barb Bennett mentioned that Al McCormick, who leads an all pace ride in the winter, will be in Florida during January and February. We will need volunteers to lead those rides.

- **Holiday Party on Saturday, Dec. 3** – Sal's Restaurant in Shrewsbury has closed so the holiday party will be at The Colts Neck Inn this year.

New Business – Harold Brenner

- **Meetings at bike shops/Guest Speakers** – At June's meeting, Harold proposed that it be put to a vote at the next meeting that if a meeting is held at a bike shop, then that bike shop's membership fee

for the year will be waived. Also, if JSTS has a guest speaker at a meeting, then a membership fee for the year will be waived for that person. After a short discussion, it was voted and approved to implement this. Charlie Kirlew suggested that it be put into the by-laws.

- **Longest Day Ride - 2012** – Jeff Mines is compiling a list of interested A/B+ riders who want to do the Longest Day Ride in mid-June, as well as anyone who can SAG. Steve Karger volunteered to SAG. Jeff is planning on having training rides early next year for this event.
- **JSTS Cotton T-Shirts** – Fred Sweet would like to get JSTS cotton t-shirts printed up so that new members can purchase one when they join up. If this is popular, Fred envisioned also getting JSTS baseball caps printed as well as a way to publicize the Club.
