

Minutes of JSTS Board Meeting - March 9, 2020

Call to order at 7:01pm; President Robert Nuara. Introduction of five board members present and twenty club members in attendance.

Motion made by President, Rob Nuara to accept the minutes of January meeting and approved.

Sheryl Nishiura, Secretary, reported no correspondence.

Treasurer's Report for January 2020 and February 2020 read by Rob Nuara. Motion made to accept financial statements made and accepted.

Committee Updates:

Membership - Jerry Korn

- IMBA Fees. Mountain Bike Advocacy Group. Club Budgeted \$100 membership fee but cost has increased to \$250. Group agreed that Club should make a \$100 donation to the organization instead of maintaining membership.
- New JSTS Magnets and window clings are now available for members and were distributed. Also new posters will be provided to bike shops.
- Frostbite T-Shirts were distributed.
